

# Southeast Austin Energy Upgrade

Austin Energy plans to replace a worn, more than 40-year-old power line running across the bottom of Lady Bird Lake. The project will:

- Tunnel beneath the lake to install **a new duct bank** for two new power lines.
- Ensure a **reliable power supply** to a significant portion of southeast Austin.

Austin Energy is working with Austin Parks and Recreation Department to minimize disruptions to the public. The boring process will begin at **Edward Rendon Sr. Metro Park** where parking for athletic programming and nearby trails may be temporarily rerouted.



New power lines will emerge on the south side of the lake at **Peace Point at Town Lake Metro Park** where nearby residences and businesses may experience outages as the lines are being energized. Temporary sidewalk and single-lane road closures may also be necessary.

The project is planned to begin late spring or early summer 2022 and is expected to take four months to complete.
