2. New Renewables come from generation facilities that first began commercial operation within the past 15 years.

For comparison, the mix of generation supplying Austin Energy for FY 2021 includes: Coal (21.0%), Nuclear (21.0%), Natural Gas (13.0%), Renewables (45.0%). This resource mix was prepared from actual power generation from Austin Energy owned/purchased generation resources.

The average home in the Austin area uses about 825 kWh per month based on Austin Energy’s analysis.
