Understanding Your Residential Solar Utility Bill

If you have solar panels at your home, your electric bill is different than bills for customers without solar panels. Austin Energy gives you credits on your bill based on how much solar power you generate. These bill credits help to cover the cost of your electricity. Solar Bill Credits

You earn a solar bill credit for every kilowatt hour (kWh) of solar energy your system produces. Currently, this credit is worth 9.91 cents per kWh for customers with system sizes under 1 MW-AC. You are billed for the total energy use of your home under the residential tiered rate structure, and then that amount is reduced by the Value of Solar credit.

The meter reads identify the amount of **energy you consumed** over the billing cycle.

The **Value of Solar bill credit** is then applied to your account, reducing the amount owed on the electric portion of your bill.

Your solar bill credit is based on the energy your system produces. **If it produces an excess after paying your electric bill, you will see a Solar Credit Balance box on your utility bill.** Any remaining credits will roll over to the next month as long as the account remains open.
